I would like to inform you of the intent of the Orange Park Association Board of directors to begin exploring the possibility of annexing all the existing county islands, which are in the Orange Park Acres Sphere of Influence, into the City of Orange. I would be most excited to lead the effort in bringing Orange Park Acres in its entirety into the City of Orange. This is where we belong and this is where we should be.

We have had a meeting with Supervisor Campbell and LAFCO representatives informing them of our desire to explore and perhaps seek annexation to the City of Orange.

We would like to invite you and another council members along with City Manager John Sibley and other staff members you care to have join us for our August 6th Orange Park Association Board meeting. Supervisor Campbell and Joyce Crosthwaite will be joining us. There may be a few others with us from Supervisor Campbell's office and from LAFCO.

Our agenda will be to answer questions the OPA Board may have on what annexation would entail; timing, voting, getting petitions signed, maintaining the OPA "uniqueness" with zoning and the keeping of animals, costs, dissention, negotiations, etc. This is purely an information meeting for our board and from our discussions we will choose a course of action.
